### **Regulation**

1. The association consists of:
  - members of the association
  - Student Council
  - executive board
2. Student Council:
  - 2.1. The Student Council is responsible for the proper execution of the association goals and objectives.
  - 2.2. The functionality of the association is based on the decisions of the Student Council.
  - 2.3. The decisions of the Student Council are adopted by majority voting.
  - 2.4. The maximum number of the Student Council members is 15.
  - 2.5. The membership to the Student Council is reviewed once a year and can be changed.
3. Executive board:
  - 3.1 Executive board is responsible for smooth and efficient functionality of the association.
  - 3.2. Executive board consists of:
    - The president of the association – is the main responsible person for the functionality of the association which is based on the Student Council decisions. President organizes and conducts meetings of the Student Council.
    - The secretary – provides information and summarizes the meetings of the Student Council.
    - The treasurer – oversees the financial activities and submits reports.

- Working groups - work in a particular direction outlined by the Student Council. Each working group has a responsible person.

3.3 The executive members as president, secretary and treasurer are elected from the Student Council members by the student council for 1 year term.

3.4 The President of the association is a member of the Executive board without a right to vote.

3.5 The candidates of the Executive body are elected anonymously.

3.6 The elections of the President are accompanied by the discussion and approval of the association activity program.

4 Each student and youth who supports the objectives of the association and adopts the regulation of the association may become a member of the association with the agreement of the Student Council.

5. Each member of the association may select the type of membership: active or regular. Active members in opposite to regular members participate in organizational activities.

6. Each member should respect all the other members of the association.

7. Each active association member can be involved in one of the working groups.

8. The membership fee is 12 € per year.

9. The regulation of the association can be changed by a proposal of the Student Council.
